An Act to amend The Industrial Wages Security Act

(Assented to , 1960)

H^{ER} MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. The Industrial Wages Security Act, being chapter 155 of the Revised Statutes, is hereby amended by adding immediately after section 8 the following:

Sa. (1) Notwithstanding section 8, the Minister may exempt from liability to furnish the security required under this Act any employer who has not made default in the payment of any wages for a period of three consecutive years immediately preceding an application for exemption.

(2) An exemption under this section shall be made by ministerial order which shall set out the period or conditions of the exemption and provide for the termination of the order upon breach of any of the conditions within the period of the order.

2. This Act comes into force on the day upon which it is assented to.
