
An Act to Greate a Department of Lands and Mines.

(Assented to , 1881)

HIS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

- 1. This Act may be ested as "The Department of Lands and Mines Act."
- In this Act, unless the context otherwise requires—
 "Department" means the Department of Lands and
 - Mines hereby created,
 (b) "Minister" means the Minister of the Department
 of Lands and Mines.
- 3. There shall be a Department of the Public Seavee of the Province of Alberta called The Department of Lands and Mines, over which the member of the Executive Council appointed by the Lieutenant Covernor under the sed of the Province to duchaige the functions of the Minister of the Department of Lands and Mines, shall presede
- 4. Shiplect to the provisions of The Pathic Service Act, the Department shall have the selementaristion of such Acts relating to lands, mones, minerals, fogether with any royal new participation of the provision of the provision of the path of the Provision of the Provision
 - 5. The Leutenant Governor in Council may, for the purpose of administration, create within the Department a bianch or branches thereof and may prescribe the duter and functions thereof and may storp, to a branch the administration of any Acis of which the Department has the administration of any Acis of which the Department has the administration.
 - 6. The Legutenant Governor in Council may appoint a Deputy Minister of Lands and Mines.

- 7. The Legisland Coverion in Council may appoint an official as like Chief Offices of any branch created personant to this Act and may confer upon such offices such of the powers of a Deputy Minister telepting to the administration of any such Act as may be apperted in the Order in Council. Provided always that the powers so conferred shall be subject to the direction and control of the Deputy Minister.
- S. The Legitemant Governor in Council may appoint such other officers, clerks or servants as may be required to entry on the business of the Department and may provide for their remuneration and presence their duties.
- 9.—(1) The Lautemant Governor in Council may appoint farse or more persons as an advisory board with the title of the Natural Resources Advisory Board, and may nonmate the charamen thereof and determine their renuneration
- (2) The board shall meet at the call of either the Minister of the charman.
- (3) The board shall act m an advisory capacity to the Minister for the purpose of forthering the administration and development of any of the natural neouvers of the Province, and shall under take such requires and travestigations as the Minister may from time to time direct.
 - 10 This Act shall come into force on the day upon which it is assented to.
