
HIS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows

1. This Act may be eited as "The Lagridian Assembly Act Amendment Act, 163;"

2 The Legislative Assembly Act, being chapter 3 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1922, is brackly amended as to section 58 therefor by stricking out the same and by substituting therefor the following:
"98. The Leedensat Governor in Council may appoint a best rate of at least, ten years' standing as Legislative.

Counsel, and may fix his remuneration and prescribe his duties?"

3. This Act thall come into force on the day upon which it is assented to
